Terms & Conditions:

Land cost for the excursion: \$3,890 per person, based on double occupancy. Single supplement is \$900.00. It is requested that you arrive in London on Thursday, September 28th, in preparation for afternoon visits to London sites. We will meet at our hotel, the Goring Hotel, 15 Beeston Place, Westminster, London SW1W 0JW, 44-20-7396-9000. This is in the Belgravia area near Buckingham Palace. Time TBD. The tour concludes on the evening of Wednesday, October 4th. October 5th is earmarked for departures from Heathrow Airport.

Contribution:

A fully tax-deductible contribution to the Institute of Classical Architecture & Art is required. A separate contribution payment of \$500 per person to the Institute's Annual Fund should be made directly to ICAA. Payment should be made by a separate donation form sent to you by Classical Excursions at the time the final tour payment is due. ICAA will then acknowledge your donation as fully tax deductible. Land Rate Includes:

A deluxe private motor coach is included for all sightseeing, visits, transfers and drives as outlined in the itinerary. The trip will be fully escorted by architectural historian Clive Aslet, former editor-in-chief and now editor-at-large of *Country Life* magazine, and Thomas Hayes, Director of Classical Excursions. Admission and guides fees are included for all sightseeing as described in the itinerary. Hotels and breakfast daily are included in the land cost along with other meals as outlined in the itinerary.

Hotel Accommodations:

Tour members are accommodated during the tour in pre-arranged 4-star hotels with basic double rooms with private baths as outlined in the itinerary. Private baths are guaranteed for all participants. Single rooms with private baths are available at an additional single supplement.

Meals:

Breakfast and lunches are included daily. One get-acquainted reception dinner and one farewell celebratory dinner are included. See the detailed itinerary for other included meals.

Tips & Taxes:

Included: service charges on hotels and restaurants as well as taxes levied by local governments and authorities.

Tour Rate Does Not Include:

Passport fee, transportation round trip from your home to airports for flights, transatlantic airfare (unless it is purchased at an additional cost from Classical Excursions), supplemental charges for single occupancy, extra meals not outlined in the itinerary, wines, liquors or other alcoholic beverages are not included in the price. Trip cancellation insurance is not included in the price; however, we can help you with this purchase and strongly advise you to purchase it.

Cancellation and Refund of Travel Arrangements:

We strongly recommend the purchase of trip cancellation/interruption insurance, which we will gladly help you with. A deposit of \$800.00 per person is requested immediately to book your space. Should it become necessary to cancel your trip before August 1, 2017, you will receive a full refund, minus a \$150.00 handling fee. After August 1st you will forfeit your \$800.00 deposit should you cancel. Full payment is due on August 10th, 2017, and forfeited thereafter if one cancels. If your space is resold and the group has a full complement of participants, we will refund your land payment even after August 1st, minus a \$150.00 handling fee. No refunds are possible for trip interruption. We urge you to purchase your own insurance to cover

cancellation/interruption covering the full price of the trip arrangements within two weeks of making your deposit.

Reservations:

A deposit of \$800.00 per person is required immediately to hold confirmed reservations. Final payment is due on or before August 10th, 2010. Upon receipt of your deposit, you will be supplied with helpful hints to assist you in preparing for the trip, and we will forward to you, a list of suggested reading materials and additional information on each of the hotels where you will stay. A study guide will be sent to you prior to trip departure.

Eligibility:

The trip requires participants to be capable of walking some distances and of climbing stairs.
